Dance Centre COVID-19 Policies & Procedures

Dance Centre's approach to managing our work in the face of COVID-19 is documented and presented to the public on our website at <https://www.dancecentreofthehamptons.com/covid-19-safety-procedures>, and is summarized here:

1. If anyone in your house is feeling unwell, please call the dance studio and let us know. We will accommodate you with a make-up lesson or, if possible, a Zoom link
2. All dance shoes must be carried in and not worn. If a dancer enters while wearing dance shoes, he or she must take their shoes outside and sanitized them with our hospital grade sanitizer to thoroughly clean them.
3. Parents and children will not be admitted to either building unless they are wearing masks. Please make sure your child has a well-fitted mask. We encourage you to bring extras, in case a mask breaks.
4. Everyone who enters the building will be checked for fever before being admitted.
5. Students and parents are required to utilize hand sanitizers, which will be available at entrance doors.
6. The waiting room is limited to no more than 10 people at a time, including staff and parents. If we are at capacity, please wait outside or in your cars, and please help us maintain proper social distancing.
7. All dancers must dance wearing masks, and if they are taking multiple classes and you must have at least 2 spare, clean masks with their belongings.
8. Parents, please note, as you must remove your mask while eating, no food is allowed in the building. An exception is made for students taking multiple classes on that day.
9. For students taking back-to-back classes: when a student is eating, there is no socializing. Please quietly eat your food, sanitize your hands, and return to the dance floor.
10. In order to maintain social distancing of at least six feet between students, classes will be limited in size, depending on the size of the studio. We have marked the dance floors with safe dance squares and spots to guide the dancers to stay safe.
11. Barres and doorknobs will be wiped down by staff before each class; use of toilets is discouraged but available if necessary.
12. Water bottles must be marked with student's name or initials, and left with belongings outside the teaching room.
13. All dressing rooms are closed.
14. If you use props or a mat, please make sure to sanitize your own prop or mat after use.

Remember: A safe environment calls for rules to protect our students and their families. Please be aware that Dance Centre will be following all government protocols with regard to COVID-19.
